

AED Defibrillator Training/Cardiac First Response

Course Background:

The provision of automated external defibrillators (AED's) in workplaces to assist in the prevention of sudden cardiac death should be considered. Early defibrillation using an AED is one of the vital links in the "chain of survival". Ideally, wherever there is an occupational first aider in a workplace, provision of an AED should be considered. The training of other employees who are not occupational first aiders in the use of AED's is also encouraged.

Course Content:

- Introduction
- Patient assessment
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Automated external defibrillator
- Recovery position
- Airway obstruction
- Heart attack / aspirin
- Stroke
- Critical incident stress management
- Handover
